A total of 16000 MASKS supplied by Reliance Foundation – India was distributed among unmasked people of all class, from small children to old one, covering people delivering EMERGENCY service to RUN the life like milkman, LPG Vendors, Hawkers, Vegetable selling people, Electricity maintenance people, Nagar Parishad karamchari, Health Staffs at Hospital & delivering services at villages.

1000 of handmade cotton masks were prepared by female volunteers & distributed all the needy & unmasked people found at road going for emergency services. Sanitizers were distributed among all with handwash practice & presentation. Thousands of people had been awared not to roam outside without most urgency to go outside.

A request was extended to Reliance Foundation – India & its representative to supply RASAN for poor & underprivileged population living on the bank of Budhi Gandak River. Request was immediatly heard & responded with no time. 100 RASAN kits had been given by Reliance foundation – India that had Mustard oil, Rice, Pulse, Spices, Salt and other raw materials.
